Acknowledging that absent students were missed, and creating a trusted adult, check-in, or interview system for historically chronically absent students. Celebrating attendance and well-being Soliciting student feedback on how to make school more welcoming and engaging <u>Discipline Strategy:</u> Statement of Commitment: We commit to creating a positive school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and builds a culture of belonging so students are more likely to come to school. Action Steps: Staff will engage in the monthly discipline discussion. Implementation of school culture and climate initiatives with a focus on belonging, relationships, cultural responsiveness with dignity, respect, & mutual concern (PBIS meetings and celebrations, SEL, Community Days, trauma-informed strategies, conflict resolution, Zones of Regulation)
